- 3. Under the Authority's Code of Conduct, where Members are offered gifts and hospitality and their value is £50 or over for a single gift/hospitality or £100 or over for all gifts/hospitality from a single source in any year, they are required within 28 days of receiving the offer to register this on the Member Gifts and Hospitality Form maintained by Democratic Services detailing the date, source and value of the gift/hospitality and whether or not such was accepted.
